


These coloured pictures are here for you to copy, or to give you some ideas for colouring.


HOW TO USE THIS COLOURING BOOK




Open the cover. Then open the flap inside the cover.



Turn to the page you want to colour




Close the flap. You can now copy the colour picture if you want to.



The ravens brought him bread and meat


And the ravens brought him [Elijah] bread and flesh in the morning, and bread and flesh

water, and pour it on


